Topics include biblical and social perspectives on age and growing older, which practical legal decisions are important for everyone, what happens when we die, and how we can live each day to the fullest...starting today.

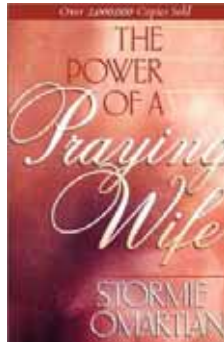

MOMs Group Starts New Fall Study



The Moms On a Mission (MOM) Bible study group will begin a new study this fall. We will be studying *The Power of a Praying Wife* by Stormie Omartian. During this study, we will explore how we can develop a deeper relationship with our husbands by praying for them and discover the fulfilling marriage God intended. Please consider joining us for this study. **Our first meeting will be Friday, September 10, for an organizational meeting** and we will start the study on Friday, September 17th. School Time Bible Education (STBE) is a time set aside during the public school day when students with parental permission may leave public school to attend off-campus Bible classes at a nearby church or non-school building.

Our model program is hosted by St. Andrews Presbyterian, Union United Methodist and Grace Point Churches. Over 50 volunteers teach, assist, and transport CrossRoads Middle School students for a nine week off-campus Bible class each year. The eighty-five minute classes are held during the elective class periods. Six classes a day are offered to meet the growing demand for the Bible class. *The off-campus Bible education class is a journey through the Bible type of class. The rigorous course of academic study covers the main characters, events and principals of the Bible from Genesis to Revelation. Over 35 students were turned away due to insufficient resources.*

Executive Summary: The School Time Bible program at CrossRoads MS will start its seventh year of operation on August 19, 2010. The 31 hour, interdenominational Bible class has been well received by the community, school officials, students and parents alike. Lexington/Richland Five School District has allowed two new schools to participate this next school year in a new pilot program. If successful, all twenty schools could allow School Time Bible classes in the near future. **So far this year we have registered 105 students; each year over 50% of the participating students are un-churched.**

Union UMC Current Involvement: One volunteer teacher and three helpers provided instruction for one of the six Bible classes for CrossRoads MS students last year. Union UMC has provided support in the amount of \$620 each of the last two years.

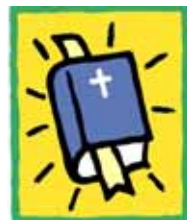
